

## **Players Early Bird Ladies League Policy As of September 2009**

### **Membership Fees**

The Players Early Bird Ladies League is a non-profit organization with a policy of no membership refunds after March 31 of the current golf season. However, fees will be refunded when a golfer has not played a game because of illness, death or being relocated.

### **Cards**

Get Well cards and sympathy cards will be sent to members as the need arises.

### **Death of a Member**

In the event of the death of a member of the league, voluntary donations will be collected. The money collected will be spent according to the wishes of the family: flowers, donation to charity etc.

### **Attendance**

A copy of the "Ineligibility Letter" will be sent by the Executive to any member who has not golfed the required number of games unless that member has been excused for reasons of illness or family emergency.

When a player is unable to complete all 9 holes in a game, but has completed at least 6 holes, that game will qualify for attendance, but will not count in the calculations of handicap.

### **Weather**

1. If the Golf course is closed for inclement weather, then all members who were signed up and had a tee time will be given credit for attendance.
  
2. If the Golf course is not closed for inclement weather, all members who were signed up, had a tee time, showed up at the golf course, (and submitted a score card signed by those who were actually there), will be given credit for attendance.
  
3. If the golf course is open but carts are not permitted, those who must use golf carts will be given credit for the game, even if they do not drive to the course (provided they had signed up for a tee time).
